2009 Helm 'Classic' Riesling *CWD* 35

In 1973 when Ken and Judith Helm established Helm wines in the Murrumbateman region grape growing had a long history but making delicate white wines did not. The subsequent releases of Helm Riesling helped change the way the world looked at Canberra Wine and its cult following amongst drinkers has proved what many locals already know. Canberra makes some of the most delicious and age worthy Rieslings in Australia.

2014 Leeuwin Estate 'Art Series' Chardonnay *Margaret River WA* 55

If wine was a boxing match Margaret River chardonnay would be the greatest pound for pound fighter in the world today. Equipped with an intoxicating combination of power and freshness the 'Art Series' effortlessly fuses a Chardonnays big moving pieces such as oak, fruit varietals, alcohol and acidity into a wine that rivals the great Chardonnays of Burgundies Cote de Beaune.

2014 Roda 'Riserva Tempranillo' *Rioja Spn* 45

From old vines deeply rooted into the soils of Rioja this Tempranillo is all about harnessed power. Its deep, rich and dark flavours are tightly bound by a muscular framework of fruit and oak tannin that make this wine taste like its straining at a leash. Time and air in the glass release its flavour and aroma resulting in a stunning wine blending the best of youth and age.

2017 Clonakilla Shiraz Viognier, *Murrumbateman NSW* 50

The wine that collectively reimaged the way Australia viewed the potential of it most popular grape variety. Inspired by his trips to the Côte-Rôtie in the Northern Rhone Valley, Tim Kirk released his first Shiraz Viognier under Clonakilla in 1992. It has risen to become one of Australia greatest wines and a flagship for the freshness, deliciousness and durability of cool climate Shiraz



Australia has a long history with Riesling. It was one of the first grape varieties planted in Australia and most likely came out with the first fleet. Its first recorded plantings were in Penrith in 1838 which also coincided with the arrival of the first group of Lutheran immigrants from Germany who landed in South Australia. With them came a history of growing and making Riesling that stretched back hundreds of years. Ken Helm who is a fourth generation wine grower is the descendant of German vinedressers from the Rhineland, who established vineyards near Albury and Rutherglen in the 1860s. Inspired by the light, refreshing and often half dry styles of Germanic Riesling Ken and his Wife Judy established Helm wines in the early 1973 in Murrumbateman. Ken and Judy's daughter, Stephanie (fifth generation wine grower) now steers the fortunes of the winery. This blend of history, destiny and inspiration has made Helm Wines one of the finest producers of Riesling in Australia.

Across the 1960's and 1970's the Australian wine drinker LOVED sweet, syrupy wines like Blue Nun, Black Tower or Liebfraumilch (Mothers Milk in German) that were made from Riesling. That era really had an impact on the general public's perception of Riesling. 'Isn't that a sweet wine?' is still the cry from many drinkers. So here's the truth on Riesling today. Its rarely sweet. Its actually dry, fresh and mouth-watering. For diners its incredibly responsive to food. No other grape variety is such transparent portal into the years fortunes of a region or vineyard. Its delicious young but it can age for 20 years or more. Australian Dry Riesling is arguably the greatest value dry white wine on earth.

SHIRAZ AND SYRAH

With its rich flavours, powerful tannins and affinity for warm climates Shiraz is a wine experience that is uniquely Australian. Syrah is the same vine as Shiraz but grows grapes that produce a very different style of wine in its place of origin, the cool climates of France's Northern Rhône Valley. The Canberra Wine District (CWD) sits squarely in the middle of these two wine styles. Possessing the potent flavours as well as freshness through its wireframe of acidity and tannins. Led by Tim Kirk and his iconic flagship wine the blending of the white grape Viognier with Shiraz is not unique to the CWD, the wines of Côte-Rôtie in the northern Rhône have used this blend for centuries. But no where outside of the Rhône Valley are wines made with this blend to a quality level as high or with more consistency as Canberra.
