CORAVIN BY THE GLASS

2014 Isole E Olena Collectzione Privata Chardonnay, *Tuscany Italy* 32

It's easy to be surprised that a world-class Chardonnay can come from Tuscany, a place more known for the moreish, savoury and mouth-filling red wines made from Sangiovese. But this wine proves just how versatile Chardonnay is. Smells like nectarines and butter on toast sprinkled with crushed nuts. It tastes lean and fresh with bottle age starting to fill out the middle palette.

2015 Yalumba 'The Signature' Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz, *Barossa SA* 31

What is an Australian Red? The answer is the blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz that is unique to Australia and responsible for some of our countries greatest dry red wines. Yalumba has been a benchmark for this style of wine since the 1880's and the first 'Signature' was released on 1962. A wine rippling with muscle and flesh and majestic tannins. Liquid power and beauty.

2010 Chateau Meyney Saint Estèphe, *Bordeaux France* 44

After the stupendous 2009 vintage in Bordeaux, no one thought it could happen again. One year later, it did. 2010 in Bordeaux produced some of their greatest dry red wines and the Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot led red wines of St Estèphe bring power, depth and richness bound with long, elongated tannins. Stunning wine and at 11 years of age starting to offer a glimpse into a wonderful future.

A LITTLE HISTORY....
